- Without another clearly articulated nexus to activity that is or would be criminal in Washington State, ALPR technology and data shall not be used to specifically target or track the movement of vehicles traveling to or from healthcare facilities, including but not limited to hospitals, clinics, mental health providers, and reproductive health care centers. This restriction applies irrespective of the vehicle's origin, destination, or the medical services sought by the individuals.

Greetings,

It was brought to my attention today (very directly) that we need to be very deliberate when offering assistance to outside agencies on pursuits. As the Sgt, you must evaluate the circumstances of the pursuit, and whether or not their pursuit meets our pursuit criteria. If it doesn't, unfortunately we won't be able to assist. If we help with a pursuit, we incur the same liability as if it was our own pursuit. If you believe the circumstances would allow us to assist, you need to be very clear in articulating over the radio what assistance we will provide. Merely announcing that "help is approved if they request it" is too ambiguous, and some of our younger officers (which is most of them) may misinterpret what you have in mind. When it comes to pursuits, we should always be erring on the side of

caution. If you're not sure if we should get involved, then we shouldn't get involved. Remember that since the pursuit law changed, not all agencies are operating on the same page when it comes to policy. Some agencies (Mill Creek and WSP come to mind) will apparently chase everyone for everything.

I trust you all to make these decisions. Please just remember that pursuits are one of the highest liability incidents we get involved in, and we absolutely have to be on top of our game.

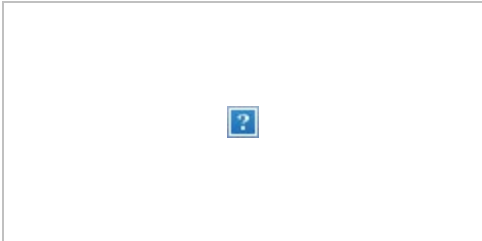

I have a few questions. These detainers have been defined as being civil. Civil is clearly different from criminal and the consequences of civil infractions are fines, not jail. Reading the federal law:

- 8 U.S. Code § 1325 makes improper entry punishable by up to 6 months in jail.
- 8 U.S. Code § 1326 makes improper re-entry a felony offense punishable by up to 20 years in prison (or less depending on the subsection).
  - In the deported felon example in the training, generally that subject would be in violation of 8 U.S. Code § 1326 (b)(1) which carries a jail sentence of up to 10 years in federal prison. Specifically that one falls under (b)(2) which carries a jail sentence of up to 20 years in federal prison.
- In the next training example the person has a "Outstanding administrative warrant." As an example, warrants have the following language, "Therefore, in the name of the State of Washington, you are commanded to arrest the defendant and keep the defendant in custody until the defendant is discharged according to law."

I understand that our certification is only to enforce state laws, and therefore not the other examples. Is the department drawing a distinction between immigration violation alerts and warrants for their arrest? I see nothing in policy, RCW 10.93.160, or Keep Washington Working, that prevents law enforcement from arresting on the warrant. If I'm

missing something please let me know. Any clarification would be appreciated.

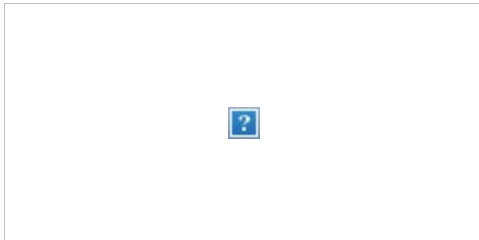

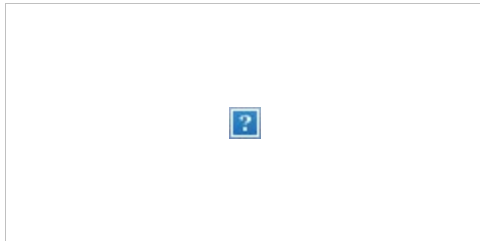
